

Requirements for Abstracts

1. The body of the abstract should be 1000-2000 characters (about 200-250 words).
2. The article title is not repeated at the beginning of the abstract.
3. The abstract is not broken into paragraphs and outlines with one straight text.
4. The structure of the abstract should briefly reflect the structure of the article and is mandatory to include: introduction; the place and results of research.

4.1. The introduction should be minimal.

4.2. The place for research is specified to the area and the region.

4.3. The results outline should contain specific information (findings, recommendations, etc.)

5. Within the abstract abbreviations are available permits when the concept of 2-3 words is replaced by the abbreviation of the appropriate number of letters. The first time the phrase is given completely but the abbreviation is indicated nearby in brackets.

Numerals, if are not the first word, are written with figures.

Using abbreviations and complex formatting elements (such as superscript and subscript) is not allowed.

It is strongly not allowed using the insert menu “Symbol”, line break, soft hyphen, the automatic hyphenation.

6. When the translating the abstract into English do not use machine translation.

All Russian abbreviations are decoded, if they have no stable analogues in English (for example: BTO-WTO; ФАО-FAO, etc.).
